Admission to the Dance Department of the MCTS Career Prep Program at the Mercer County Community College is by audition only. For your audition come prepared to:

1. Demonstrate technical abilities through participation in a brief class, which will include combinations of ballet, modern, and jazz disciplines.
2. Perform a short dance of any style that highlights your technical strength and performance ability. Please bring a cassette or compact disc of your music, labeled with your name, cued up and ready to play.
3. Speak about your training and why you want to study dance at MCTS Career Prep Program at Mercer County Community College.

All dance applicants should be dressed in dance clothes that allow the dancers to demonstrate clean lines and the ability to dance both with shoes and barefoot. All applicants should bring ballet slippers and jazz shoes. Female applicants should wear either footless or convertible tights and a simple leotard. Male applicants should wear either tights or jazz pants and a fitted tee shirt.
